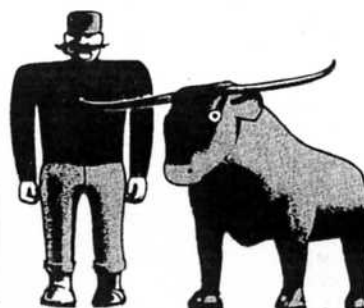
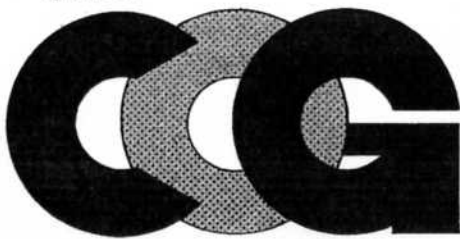

Remember Rotary Magazines in April

April is Magazine Month, a time to acknowledge the importance of the Rotary magazines, which serve as an indispensable source of information for Rotarians around the World.

The Rotarian, published since 1911, serves about 500,000 subscribers. From the first 12-page black-and-white newspaper printed 91 years ago to the colorful 64-page magazine we know today, *The Rotarian* has always kept pace with the needs of its readers, disseminating news about the policies, leaders, programs, and activities of RI and The Rotary Foundation. Selected articles from *The Rotarian* also appear on the RI Web site each month.

Some 750,000 subscribers read the 27 regional magazines published in 20 languages. Regional magazines include some material from *The Rotarian* as well as localized coverage of club projects. Many of the regional magazines have a presence on the Web as well.

The editors of *The Rotarian* offer a free "magazine kit," which includes guidelines for submitting club news to the editors and background information on *The Rotarian* and the regional magazines that can be used to spread the word about the magazines during Magazine Month.
