Chicago Centennial Convention

Travel arrangements for District 5580:

P&J Tours is offering a transportation package for member of Rotary clubs in our district. Dates of the travel package are June 18-23, 2005 – 6 days.

It includes motorcoach transportation to and from Chicago, with pickup points at various locations in our district; five nights at the Hilton Hyatt, Embassy Suites or Double Tree hotels located in and near Oak Brook Center; five full breakfasts, and baggage handling. Transportation is provided from the hotel to the McCormick Place.

The price per person is \$530 for a Double, and \$784 for a Single. A deposit of \$125 is due at reservation; final payment is due December 31, 2004.
