**ROTARY AROUND THE WORLD**

**EGYPT** – In 2008-09, the Rotary Club of El Tahrir took on a US\$467,000 project to improve conditions for people in Om Dinar, a village outside Cairo. The club made micro-credit loans; renovated a youth center, a medical clinic, and three schools; conducted seminars on topics such as hygiene, health, and drugs; and distributed items such as food, blankets, and clothing. The club met with members of a local community development group every Saturday to discuss the project; now, it sponsors that group as a Rotary Community Corps.

A Rotary Community Corps is made up of non-Rotarians working to improve their community in cooperation with a sponsor Rotary Club. There are more than 6,600 Corps in 78 countries and geographical areas.
