ROTARY AROUND THE WORLD

Norway – Polio is no laughing matter, but in Norway, raising money for it is. The Rotary Club of Gamlebyen-Fredrikstad is selling a compilation of 1,201 jokes and humorous tales collected from the 330 Rotary clubs in the country to raise money for Rotary's US\$200 Million Challenge. For every book sold, \$12 of the \$50 cover price goes toward the challenge, and organizers hope to raise \$100,000. (They've raised more than \$50,000 so far.)
